Other Site Characteristics

This territory is a fragment of woodlands in the interfluvial area of the rivers Pina and Pripyat with the prevalence of broad-leaved species. The northern part is swamped. Natural or slightly transformed territories form about 50% of the area.

4.2 Quality and importance

Hornbeam-oak woods (G1.A1) occupy the significant area of the site. The following bird species are found here: Dendrocopos medius, Grus grus and others. The site territory is a very important habitat for the following species: Coenonympha oedippus, Maculinea teleius, Maculinea nausithous as well as for growth of Cypripedium calceolus. There are over 100 plants of this species here. A number of other orchid species grow here as well.
