Other Site Characteristics

The area is situated in the the Luninets and Gantsevichi Regions of the northern part of the Brest Oblast, in the Pripyat Polesye physiographic district. It is a woodland and wetland complex in the interfluvium of the Lan and Tsna rivers interfluvium. The area is heavily moistened due to high level of groundwater occurrence. It is very important for feeding regional rivers and swamps and maintenance of the weather and climatic conditions. Almost the entire area is heavily drained by the Plyasa, Krinichnaya, Strizhevsky, Zaozerye canals. Pine and birch forests prevail. The

area is characterized by forest islets among swamps, many of which are hardly accessible. Wetlands of all three main types are present there, with lowland swamps prevailing.

4.2 Quality and importance

First of all, the area is of international importance for preserving a globally endangered species – the большой подорлик, aquila clanga – with at least 1-2% of the national population of the species breeding there. Besides, this wetland and woodland complex is highly important for preserving a number of forest bird species, as well as woodland and waterland inhabiting species: the great grey owl, strix nebulosa; the black stork, ciconia nigra; the short-toed snake eagle, circaetus gallicus; the white-backed woodpecker, dendrocopos leucotos; the middle spotted woodpecker, dendrocopos medius; the European nightjar, caprimulgus europaeus. Besides, a large area at the site is occupied by biotopes of open upland swamps, sphagnous birch forests, mesotrophic swamps and upland swamps covered by pine forests.
